DESCRIPTION OF HALLBERG-RASSY 310

This lovely Hallberg-Rassy offers excellent sailing performance and comfort in a compact and versatile size. With its high quality and beloved Scandinavian design, this boat appeals to experienced sailors and families seeking safety and performance for long adventures or short day trips at sea.

With the 310, Hallberg-Rassy has managed to create impressive space, with a salon table, berth lengths, and headroom similar to boats nearly 40 feet long. The smart interior is not only functional but also classically stylish with beautiful, light mahogany and ample natural light through large hatches and numerous windows.

The salon is brightly furnished with comfortable sofas that easily convert into wide berths for two. On the starboard side, there's a practical L-shaped galley, complete with storage space, stove, oven, and refrigerator. A spacious aft cabin is to port, while the bow hosts a surprisingly roomy head with shower and a forward cabin for two.

The cockpit is well-protected with a partially openable windshield and sprayhood. Long benches offer ample space for the entire crew, and there's a truly spacious storage locker to starboard. With the tiller folded up, the cockpit offers an incredible amount of space. The stern is partially open for easy access to the dock or for swimming.

The Hallberg-Rassy 310 surprises with excellent sailing abilities, garnering high ratings even from the international press.

Steering with a tiller gives a wonderful sense of balance and allows for quick, precise rudder movements.

The deck layout is designed for smooth and safe sailing, even when single-handed.

The boat is in very good condition, well-equipped, and has no notable groundings or other damage.
