The classic center cockpit design provides a secure and protected sailing environment, while the deck layout has been carefully arranged for effortless handling, whether sailing short-handed or single-handed.

Tess is comprehensively equipped for comfortable and efficient passagemaking. On deck, she features electric Lewmar winches, a hydraulic Furler headsail furling system, hydraulic boom vang, and hydraulic backstay tensioner. Together, these systems provide excellent sail control and allow for easy sail handling, even in demanding conditions.

The bow thruster is operated through the traditional foot controls at the helm, while a hydraulic passerelle at the stern simplifies docking and Mediterranean mooring.

The sail inventory from Hamel Sails is complemented by a fixed inner forestay, providing exceptional versatility for both coastal cruising and offshore passages. The sails are in good condition and offer many seasons of reliable service ahead.

Interior – Designed for Comfortable Living Aboard

The interior reflects Hallberg-Rassy's renowned craftsmanship, featuring beautifully finished joinery, thoughtful design solutions, and generous living spaces. From the moment you step below deck, you are welcomed by a warm and inviting atmosphere that makes Tess equally appealing as a luxury cruising yacht and a comfortable liveaboard home.

To starboard is the spacious U-shaped galley, offering ample workspace, an easily accessible refrigerator, and a separate freezer conveniently located adjacent to the navigation station. This practical arrangement is especially appreciated during extended cruising, where functionality and comfort are essential.

The main saloon features a large U-shaped settee to starboard and the signature Hallberg-Rassy armchairs to port. Large windows and well-positioned deck hatches create a bright and airy environment filled with natural light.
