DESCRIPTION OF NAJAD 391

Najad 391 is a well-designed boat model, a quality build from bow to stern. This specimen is well-maintained for its age. The interior is meticulously crafted, meeting almost exaggerated quality standards. Beautiful woodwork from deck to ceiling throughout the boat creates a sense of luxury and comfort on board. Najad 391 is a boat that performs well while sailing in our archipelagos but is equally at home wherever on the seas.

The layout is designed for a sailing couple or a family of two children seeking a comfortable life on board. In the aft, there's an owner's cabin, a large aft cabin that accommodates two substantial berths, plenty of cabinets, storage compartments, and seating. In the bow, you'll find a generously sized forepeak with ample space and storage. Originally, this boat was built with a large toilet with a shower in the aft, and the separate shower space in the bow has been removed. Consequently, this makes the forepeak very spacious.

The salon is both cozy and spacious with ample space around the large table. The bathroom is roomy and includes both toilet and shower, expanded beyond standard to a considerably larger space. The L-shaped kitchen is well-planned with plenty of workspace and a substantial fridge with smart opening and clever baskets that facilitate organization and tidiness.

Everything is well-arranged for a delightful vacation in our waters, a second home on the water, or a sailing trip around the world (or parts thereof). Swedish boat-building tradition from Henån that brings joy and pride.
