DESCRIPTION OF BENETEAU OCEANIS 40.1

A modern, stylish, and well-sailing boat with clever solutions typical of French Beneteau. This Oceanis 40.1 has 4 cabins and ample space both outdoors and indoors for up to 10 people.

The Oceanis 40.1 sails surprisingly well in light winds yet stiff in heavier weather, thanks to its hull shape with characteristic step and a well-balanced sail plan.

Beneteau has combined modern design with timeless elegance, making the Oceanis 40.1 a popular model. The interior is spacious, filled with natural light and features large hull windows. In the saloon, there is a well-equipped galley along the starboard side and a navigation station to port.

Even a larger crew fits comfortably around the large saloon table with cozy seating.

Aft, there are two large cabins, and to starboard, a spacious toilet with a separate shower.

Forward, there's a smaller cabin with bunk beds and a surprisingly large cabin with a broad double berth. There's also a smaller toilet with a shower.

Wide and secure steps lead to the cockpit.

Both in- and outdoors you'll find ample storage space, even for longer voyages.

With twin wheels, the Oceanis 40.1 offers a practical and spacious cockpit with long benches and a large, sturdy table with flaps.

The transom can be lowered to create a broad and comfortable bathing platform, also providing easy access to the dock.

The deck layout is optimized for efficient and comfortable sailing, with the possibility for a self-tacking jib.

The boat has a retractable bow thruster to facilitate harbor maneuvers.

Twin rudder blades provide excellent grip and control even in tougher conditions without making the boat heavy on the helm.

This Oceanis 40.1 is in excellent condition, without grounding or any noticeable damage.

Winter-stored in a warm hall. Sold by the first owner.

Included in the price is that the boat will be delivered serviced and launched in the spring of 2024 in Dalsbruk!
