DESCRIPTION OF NAUTICAT 32

The interior is designed to be both beautiful and functional at sea. The large windows provide plenty of light, and the beautiful, handcrafted wood surfaces create a wonderful sense of quality. The superstructure is also entirely made of fiberglass, making it easy to maintain and it's watertight.

In the bow, there is a cabin with a large V-berth. Forward of the saloon, the toilet is to port and the well-equipped galley to starboard. Under the aft deck, there is another spacious cabin with a double berth.

The cozy saloon is the heart of the boat, where the entire crew will surely enjoy themselves and can take in the unobstructed view in all directions, even when the weather is cold and wet. Around the large table, everyone can sit comfortably, and it can also be lowered to create an extra berth.

The ability to maneuver the boat from inside is surely appreciated by the helmsman, who doesn't have to freeze alone in the cockpit in bad weather!

All spaces are smartly utilized for storage with cabinets and drawers, even the nautical charts have their own pull-out drawer.

The engine is well insulated under the saloon floor, and the bow thruster assists in harbor maneuvers.

This Nauticat 32 is in good condition with regular updates made!
